

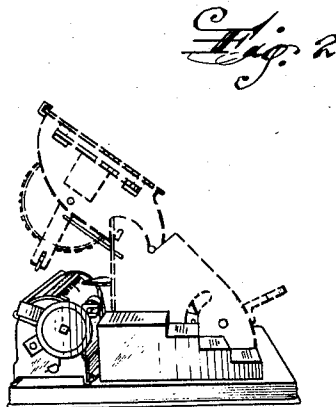
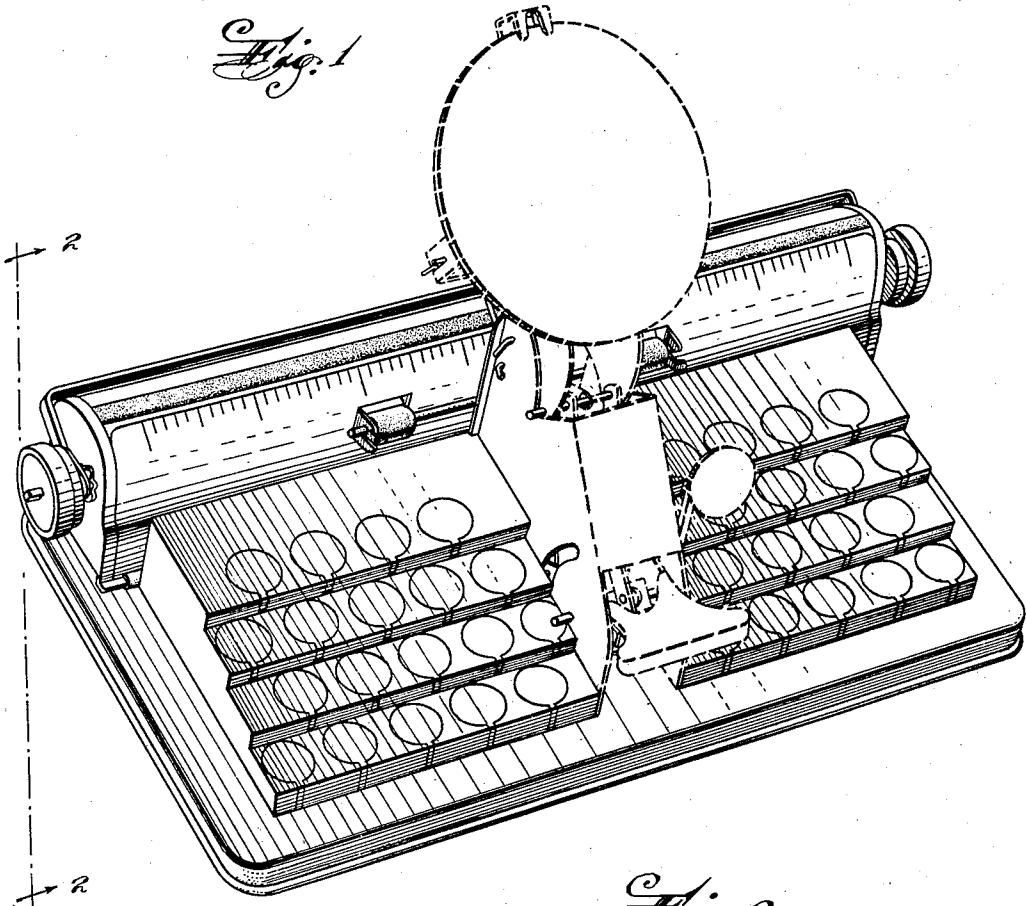

DESIGN FOR A TOY TYPEWRITER

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Samuel I. Berger, a citizen of the United States, residing at 194 Waverly Avenue, in the city of Newark, county of Essex, and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Toy Typewriter, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a toy typewriter embodying my new design,

Fig. 2 is a perspective view taken on a smaller scale and looking at the typewriter from the side in the direction of line 2—2 of Fig. 1.

The characteristic features of my design are shown in full lines in the drawing.
